## Internet Archive is...

### A 2 million book archive

The Text Archive contains a wide range of fiction, children's books, historical texts and academic books.



### Tons of movies & animation

Over 250,000 movies including classic full-length films, animation and alternative news broadcasts.



### Thousands of recordings

75,000 live concerts including the Grateful Dead and over 3,000 other artists. Over 500,000 audio recordings too.



### Open Library

The wikipedia of books. There are currently 500,000 texts for the print disabled in DAISY format.



### NASA Images

In partnership with NASA, we provide access to over 150,000 archived NASA images.



### Archive-It

Allows institutions to build and preserve collections. There are currently over 1,000 public collections.



### The Wayback Machine

The Wayback Machine lets you browse through over 150 billion web pages archived from 1996 to a few months ago.



### Scanning

Internet Archive staff scan on average 1,000 books per day. There are currently 21 locations in 6 countries.

### About Internet Archive

Internet Archive is a 501(c)(3) non-profit library. The Archive actively collects, creates and provides access to archives of digital media including texts, audio, movies, web pages and software collections.

### Every day there are:

- 1,000 books scanned
- 1 million visitors to archive.org
- 200,000 books downloaded
- 50,000 concerts streamed
- 650,000 movies downloaded
- 500,000 visitors to Wayback Machine
