

### THE CHALLENGE

- \* Migrate data from individual files into a database that was easily update-able by several people.
- \*\* Provide a public interface that was functional to start and expandable in the future.
- **Do it with little to no impact on budget or staffing.**



### WHY A BLOG?

- # Handles structured data well in a database backend with little overhead.
- Designed to be a multi-user environment with layers of authorization.
- **Flexible, familiar interface.**
- **Existing technology that is easily modified.**



### WHY A BLOG?

### THE PROCESS

- **Submitted a proposal to the Committee.**
- Installed WordPress and modified themes, css, and php scripts to create two prototypes.
- Manually converted narrative items to blog pages and a handful of html files to blog posts for proof of concept.
- **The Committee reviewed the prototypes.**
- We Used php scripts to extract data from the AU site and load into MySQL database.
- **Performed automated and manual clean-up.**
