
bX Configuration at Washington University in St. Louis

Script is placed in the Footer section of the 360 Link configuration:

<script type="text/javascript" src="http://[your server name]/[your bX filename].js"></script>

The script itself contains a reference to the bX recommender service at Ex Libris – with our proxy prepend on the URL:

```
var bX_base =
'http://libproxy.wustl.edu/login?url=http://recommender.service.
exlibrisgroup.com/service/';
```

Thus all 360 Link menus contact our EZproxy server, whether the user is on-campus or off.

EZproxy is configured thus:

```

ExcludeIP.

AutoLoginIP 172.16.0.0 - 172.31.255.255

This passes through on-campus users without requiring them to log in, but allows the bX service to be configured with just one IP address – that of our proxy server – rather than our entire University IP range, which Ex Libris requested. These lines reside in config.txt near the top of the file, prior to the Exclude IP statements for the campus IP ranges and prior to all other resource stanzas.
